We are continually updating our risk assessments alongside updated guidance. We will be installing more hand sanitising stations across school and would ask any parents who do not wish their children to access 'sanitiser gel' to make us aware (This may be due to medical condition, such as Eczema)

### Seaton Crew Breakfast

If your child requires breakfast when using breakfast childcare can you please ensure that they arrive on or before the 8am timeslot. This is so staff have enough time to clean the hall in time to start the school day.

### Pupil Collection

Can we please remind you to let the school office, or the class teacher know, if another parent is collecting your child from school. If another member of your family regularly collects your child please let the teacher know by writing this in their Fish Diary. This way we can ensure all children are safely collected by the correct adult.

### Parking

We have received a number of complaints from parents and residents about parking and dangerous manoeuvres at the top of Crawford Street/Deacon Gardens. This includes reversing at speed, 3 point turns and parking on pavements. As Year 5 and Year 6 are accessing school via the front gate this is putting them in danger. Can I also remind you that Crawford Street is a residents only parking which is patrolled on a regular basis by HBC Traffic Enforcement Team

We have now got a dedicated email address for parents to use to email any test results to. Not only will this enable us to monitor when negative test results are returned enabling children to return to school but will also enable us to be alerted to a positive result as soon as possible so that we can put the necessary actions in place.
