Hair: For ALL pupils

If hair is worn long (below shoulder length), it must be tied up or back, for hygiene reasons.

- head shaven at one side,
- shaved parting and longer hair on top and over to one side,
- mohawks
- tramlines
- rats tails
- spikes
- shapes
- colours, bleach and hairstyles created by gel/wax
