

## Curriculum Coverage for Year 2 Autumn Term



Curriculum Area	Coverage
<b>English</b>	This term children will be covering the book 'Fantastic Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl to develop their writing and reading. The majority of their writing lessons will be based around this book; covering a range of genres across the term. Alongside this, the children will continue to engage in phonics sessions to develop their reading and writing skills.
<b>Mathematics</b>	This term the children will be concentrating on their knowledge of number and place value. Following this the children will develop their knowledge of measurement (length and mass), multiplication and division applying this to problem solving.
<b>Science</b>	During the first half term we will cover 'Animals including Humans'. The children will learn more about life cycles and what is important for growth and development. We will then move onto the topic 'Living Things and Their Habitats' where the children will explore the difference between things that are living, dead as well as things that have never been alive.
<b>Religious Education</b>	During this term your child will be learning about the God and Creation. We will first reflect on what Christians believe God is like, making connections to our lives as Christians. Next we will develop our understanding of God the Creator; thinking about who made the beautiful world we live in.
<b>Computing</b>	During this half term we will focus on the topic 'Safety Online'. Children will develop their understanding of using technology safely, responsibly and respectfully and how to keep themselves safe when using the internet.
<b>History Geography Art and Design</b>	Our topic for this term is The World. We will learn about the continents, oceans and hot and cold areas of the world. We will also look closer at our local area and create a map of Seaton Carew with a key and symbols to represent human and physical characteristics.
<b>Music</b>	We will be experimenting and combining a range of sounds using inter-related dimensions in music. Children will be encouraged to use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.
<b>P.E</b>	Your child will be given the opportunity to work with qualified coaches. We will also cover multi-skills where your child will develop a range of P.E. related skills. Please ensure your child's full indoor and outdoor kit is in school at all times.
<b>Homework</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Every Tuesday your child will be bringing home a set of spellings to learn, they will be tested every Monday. It is their responsibility to practice their key words at home.</li> <li>• Your child is aware of their own personal targets for their times table challenge. Please practice these at home with your child.</li> <li>• Your child will also be given homework every Thursday, which is expected to be completed by the following Wednesday.</li> <li>• Your child is expected to make three reading comment entries into the reading record each week. Please monitor your child's reading at home.</li> </ul>
