As part of the National Curriculum pupils are taught about using the internet and internet safety and from Year 3 are given their own website and e-mail account on our secure learning platform. This is a monitored educational site however your permission is required to allow your child access to the site.

HTTV

Our pupils take part in a schools TV and film making. The HTTV Crew help develop understanding and knowledge of TV and how it impacts on each of our daily lives. Pupils have access to a variety of equipment e.g. cameras, tripods. They learn about copyright permission & terminology. They film weekly news events and interview other pupils and staff, edit the films, add voiceovers, titles, add any effects and write the script and links. Finally they produce the programme by converting the film in the software then upload it to The Learning Platform. Pupils may appear on the films in a variety of ways - being interviewed, in the background or by taking part in an event being filmed.
