Trailblazer

Our school has opted to be part of an exciting new project offering support and early intervention around children and young people's mental health and emotional wellbeing. This is collaboration between Alliance Psychological Services, Tees Esk and Wear Valley CAMHS and our school. The Mental Health Support Team will be coming into our school to help raise awareness around emotional wellbeing. The team will work with us to create a whole school approach to wellbeing and help families to be supported in the right way at the right time. The aim of the team is to promote resilience, encourage the development of self-care skills and self-help techniques and explore different coping strategies. They will be working with children and young people experiencing mild to moderate traits of low mood, anxiety and behaviour. This will be done through 1-1 interventions with children, group work, parental support or signposting to more suitable organisations. The Mental Health Support Team will be coming into school on Thursday 6th February to deliver an assembly and introduce themselves to pupils. We are very excited about this opportunity and would like to invite you to a meeting in school to find out about the Trailblazer on Thursday 6th February at 8:50am. If you are concerned about the wellbeing of your child, please contact Mrs Wheeldon who can offer guidance and put you in touch with the Mental Health Support Team for more information.
