HOMWORK

Children will be expected to complete the below at home:

Reading:

- Independently complete three books on Reading Plus (ensuring all reading and vocabulary sections are completed as daily reading time will be provided in school).
- Three reading comments in their Reading Diary.

Spelling:

- The spelling and handwriting worksheets in their yellow Spelling homework book.

Mathematics:

- An assignment will be set on either MathsShed or Times Tables Rock Stars.

Your child's homework will be sent out on a Tuesday and needs to be completed and returned to school on the following Monday.

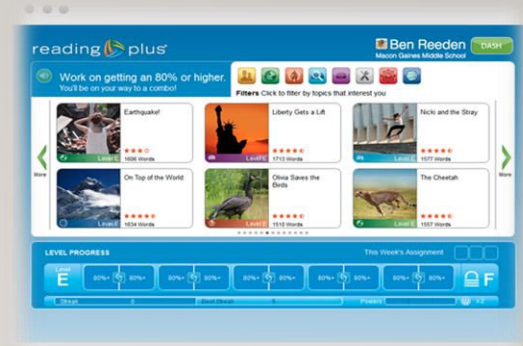
Children will get raffle tickets for completing these tasks.



SPELLINGS

- Spellings rules are taught in class and given Tuesday.
To be completed and returned Monday.
- The children can practice their spellings on Spelling Shed, but they must complete the spelling and handwriting worksheets in their yellow spelling books.
- When children complete their spelling homework, they will receive a spelling token which will go towards a raffle at the end of each half term.
- Spelling homework that is not completed will be done during break times.

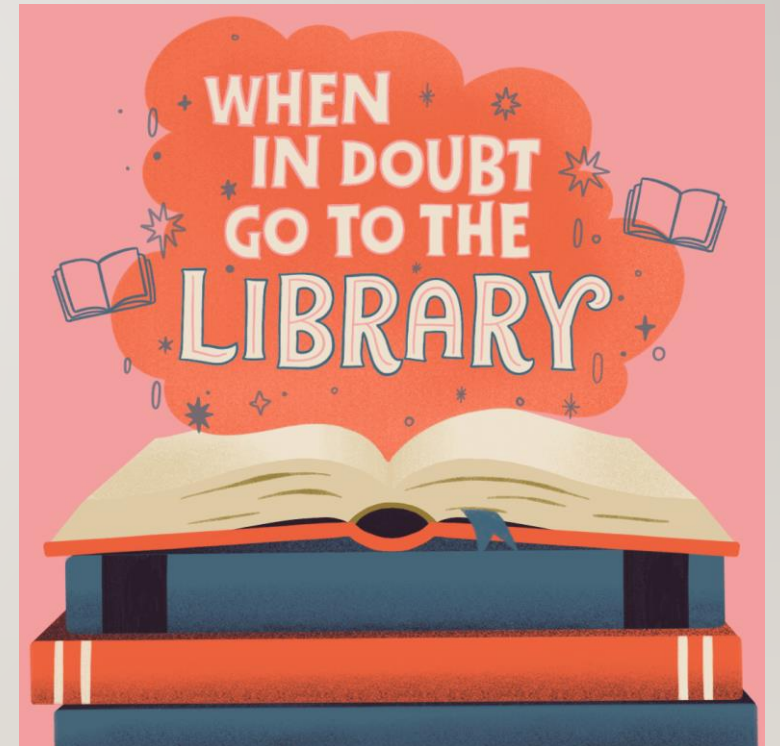
READING FOR PURPOSE: READING PLUS...



- Reading Plus is an adaptive literacy solution that improves fluency, comprehension, vocabulary, stamina, and motivation.
- Children complete assigned reading tasks in both comprehension, vocabulary and visual skills.
- Reading Plus is completed daily at school and we ask that your child for homework completes three books at home so it is 100% completed by the end of the week.

READING FOR PLEASURE: ACCELERATED READING

- With Accelerated Reader, a student reads a book, takes an online quiz, and gets immediate feedback. Students respond to regular feedback and are motivated to make progress with their reading skills.
- Your children will be given daily time in class to complete the reading of their accelerated reading book.
- Also, they will need to complete three reading comments in their reading diary at home about their book.










MATHS








- We follow the Whiterose scheme. These are research-based schemes of learning which are designed to support a mastery approach to teaching and learning and are consistent with the aims and objectives of the National Curriculum.
- We follow the Mastery approach to teaching mathematics, aiming for a deepened understanding of the curriculum. This involves being able to problem solve by applying knowledge to word problems (identifying important information) and explaining how and why to approach a problem in a particular way.
- We use the resources provided which include reasoning and problem solving questions.






MARVEL-LOUS MATHS

- The children will be continuing their Marvellous Maths tests every half term. If your child is not up to their current age group then regular tests will be given to ensure that child is caught up to their year group. The children will stop taking the tests once they have completed their year group superheroes.
- This will allow us to see which information the children have retained and which information needs to be taught.
- The aim is that the children will be able to answer 1 question in less than 6 seconds.

TIMES TABLES ROCK STARS



- Times Tables Rock Stars is an award-winning maths learning platform that helps pupils practise and recall their times tables like a rock star, using paper worksheets, and playing online adaptive question-based games via the app and browser.

RECAPPING MATHEMATICAL METHODS: ARITHMETIC TESTS, FLUENCY LESSONS AND MATHS JOURNALS.

We will complete weekly arithmetic tests to help your child to improve their recall of mathematical methods.

Also, we will be adding in 10 - 15 minute fluency sessions daily. This will recap their learning of mathematical methods from Year 4.

Maths Journals - the children will be using these as a revision guide to record down key information about the new mathematical methods they are learning in their Maths lessons.

FLASHBACK 4

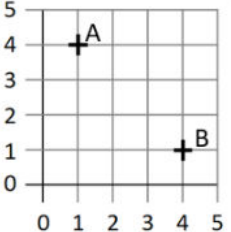
- It is designed to improve children's recall of the key arithmetic procedures required to be at ARE (age related expectations) in their year group. The purpose is to increase fluency in maths and provide consistent revision of arithmetic, helping children to retain information from lessons.
- Flashback 4 is four mathematical questions which recap previous learning. The children are given 10 minutes to answer the questions and then as a class we discuss and mark the questions.
- We don't expect to see full marks every day but expect to see an improvement gradually.

SWIMMING
